Harrods Creek Watershed Team Meeting - August 27, 2014

1. Introductions and Overview

Everyone introduced themselves. Tessa gave a general overview of the Harrods Creek Watershed planning project.

2. Mission Statement and Logo Discussion

It had previously been suggested by team members that the group have a clear mission statement and a logo. Austin told the group about some logo and website ideas. The discussion about a mission statement will take place at a later meeting.

3. Event Planning

Meeting attendees broke into three groups to brainstorm events for the Harrods Creek Watershed Team. The purpose of the events may range from educational to volunteer recruitment to fundraising. Everyone was asked to focus not only on the ideas, but the detailed planning such when, where, who, and how as well. Each group then reported back to the team.

Group 1

Group 1 advised making a Blackout Date list. They took a seasonal approach to event ideas:

Autumn

- Amazing Watershed Challenge
- Bat Education
- Night Photography

Winter

- Wildlife Tracking
- Pecha Kucha

- Spring and Summer - Creek Seining (on private land or at Covered Bridge Road)
- Clean-up
- Wildflower Hike
- Salamander Egg Hunt
- Duck Boxes and Bird Houses
- Native Plant Education

Group 2

- Biological and Habitat Sampling Training: this could take place in April or May of 2015 and could be led by the Salt River Watershed Watch group.

- Trash Mobs: this idea is to do short, frequent clean-ups with a social component afterwards. For example, pick up trash for one hour in downtown LaGrange, and then go out for ice cream. This gets rid of trash and thus keeps it from washing into the creek. It's also an opportunity to talk about stormwater pollution and watershed basics. Need to get in touch with the Oldham County Solid Waste Coordinator.

- Wolfstock: collaborate with Creasey Mahan on this August event. Put Harrods Creek logo on doggie waste bags and give out to people for free. This would also be a potential speaking engagement.

Group 3

- Creasey Mahan Wildflower Walk expanded to Wildflowers and Water: this Creasey Mahan event is tentatively scheduled for April 18, 2015. There are springs and sinkholes on the property that would provide great teaching opportunities.

- Creasey Mahan event Froggie Day could be adapted to include watershed education messages. This event is scheduled for June 20, 2015.

- Nature Slam (a Pecha Kucha style event): could be a family-friendly event (to include beer and wine) possibly at Fox Hollow (if they are amenable).

- Paddle and Picnic on Harrods Creek – this could be an educational/interpretive event. Need to find a good place to launch and picnic. Also may need to find a source of boats.

- Louisville 50 Boat Race – Oct. 4, 2015. We could table this event.

- Tour of Farms of Oldham County: event scheduled for July 2015. We could table this event.
