**Baxter on Hwy 413. Turn at DQ, cross bridge and turn left. Access road goes to site underneath rail bridge into long straight of water. Several access points available downstream on 413. Lots of large and small items including tires. Can bring items up into church parking lot. Continue downstream as time allows. Water is deep near bridge, shallow downstream.**

**Baxter on Hwy 413. Turn at DQ, cross bridge and turn right. Site at railroad crossing south of Rosspoint over steep hill. If parking is needed, continue to Shepherd Drive and turn right to last home. Gary Howard has access to county owned land by river. Large items including couches and other furniture and lumber. Truck needed on site because there is no place to pile the refuse.**

**Clem Road off US 119.** Park at Mary Clem's house, unplug the electric fence and cross cow pasture. Easy entrance. Only a little trash, good place for kids or to start working downstream.

Private property. Take out.

**US 119 on Left.** Dirt road leads directly to river. Small debris at entrance. Good place to start working downstream.  
**\*Paddlers only recommended.**

**Salvage yard past Totz on US 119.** Enter through gate and cross field. **Heavy equipment needed** for multiple vehicles, utility poles, etc. Small and medium items mixed in including tires.

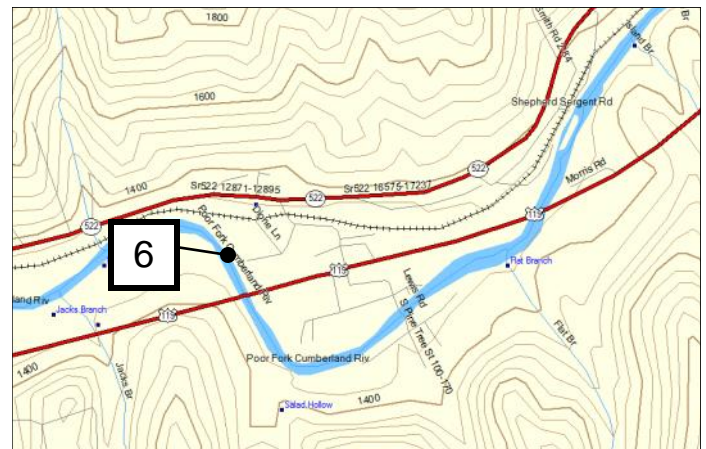
**Lewis / Warren Drive at Dione.** Turn into community and then left into trailer park. Park at end of road. Garbage and some small furniture. Good place to start working down-

**Morris Bottom Road then follow grassy road on left to riverbank near bridge.** A few small items. Good spot to start paddling and working downstream.

**Just past Hiram sign directly below south end of bridge. Steep entrance.** Garbage and brush piling against shoreline. Small items and a wooden palette.

**Gravel road on right before bridge at Coal Town. Bear to right after turning onto gravel road. One dump along the road on the right. Two riverside dumps on left down steep hill below road.** Lots of large items including mattresses, furniture, toilet. More debris in water including tires. Scout entire area for additional dumping.

# 10

**Gap in fence just south of cemetery leads to steep riverbank. Small foot trail above the bank to left. May want to look for better access from cemetery.** Large and small items. Lots of metal items needs dug from bank including shopping cart and a few carpets. Sheet of metal or wood in center of water. Some kind of tarp and other debris stuck in shallows on opposite side.
