We replaced septic systems that were leaking into the river, cleaned up trash and tires in the river, educated local students and adults, and engaged the community in the Wild & Scenic Red River Festival. We also have supported the Beargrass Creek Alliance, organizing meetings, hosting cleanups, and participating in the watershed plan with the Louisville Metropolitan Sewer District. We support the Salt River and Green River Watershed Watch groups, as well as other organizations that work to protect and restore waterways across the state.
